Manitoba School Improvement Program – The Peaceful Village Inc. (MSIP-TPV) is currently recruiting up to four (4) volunteer Board Members (term commencing May 2024).

MSIP-TPV is an independent, non-profit, non-governmental organization that runs "The Peaceful Village Program". This Program promotes the advancement of education for disadvantaged youth (particularly newcomer youth) and assists them in achieving their potential through promoting positive social connections in a safe afterschool space.

The program provides students with academic support, learning materials, meals and other activities (including field trips, volunteer opportunities, and student exchanges). MSIP-TPV currently runs Six (6) successful school sites and one community site throughout the City of Winnipeg with over 800+ student participants. In addition, MSIP-TPV provides a community for newcomer families and adults through provision of English as an Additional Language classes, and citizenship assistance classes.

Our Board of Directors supports MSIP-TPV and its community by providing governance, and providing guidance in strategic planning for the organization.
